Dr. Thu Dinh spoke on Meat Science, Dr. Jean Feugan presented reproductive biotechnology and biophotonics, and Ph.D. student, Muhammet Ugur, spoke about sperm fertility.

Ph.D. students, Mauricio Oliveira, from Dr. Amanda Stone's research group. and Courtney Heaton from Dr. Clay Cavinder's research group, respectively discussed contemporary research on dairy cattle and horse physiology.

Dr. Henry Paz has presented his research on microbiome of digestive systems in cattle. Dr. Erdogan Memili shared his research on functional genomics and epigenomics of bull fertility and research opportunities for undergraduates.

Dr. Elder explained how the Provost Scholars Program identifies promising young adults and encourages their engagement in undergraduate research.


