The Department of Animal and Dairy Sciences at Mississippi State University is seeking applications for the position of Assistant Extension Professor with emphasis in equine nutrition, forages, reproduction, or health. The position is a 100% Extension 12-month non-tenure track appointment

The successful candidate will be responsible for providing statewide leadership and support of the equine industry with emphasis on adult education (75%) and Youth 4-H programs (25%). Specific responsibilities include: develop an equine extension program that addresses the educational needs of equine producers and industry allied services; work cooperatively with the College of Veterinary Medicine on programs that serve the state and region; deliver statewide educational programs and develop educational materials, workshops, and in-service training for adults and 4-H youth, county extension personnel, and allied industries. The incumbent will work cooperatively and as a team with other extension and research professors, extension area agents, county extension personnel, and industry leaders to accomplish the mission of the Mississippi State University Extension Service. The Assistant Professor will develop educational materials, publications, and other media for use by extension staff and clientele. Additional duties include seeking external funds to support equine programs and working with the therapeutic riding program, regional equine extension programming efforts in the Southeast U.S. and actively participating in regional and national equine extension programs. The candidate must also have demonstrated excellent oral and written communication skills.
